3. Hazardous Identification

First Aid measures:

Highly flammable and explosive vapours

Eyes:

Irrigate with clear water and OBTAIN IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION.

Skin:

Wash with soap and water and remove contaminated clothing. Remove person to fresh air. Keep warm and at rest.

Inhalation:

Apply artificial respiration if breathing has ceased or shows signs of failing.

OBTAIN IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION. Wash out mouth with water. Do NOT induce vomiting. Give Milk or water.

Ingestion: OBTAIN IMMEDIATE MEDICAL ATTENTION.

Fire Fighting Measures:

Use CO<sub>2</sub>, alcohol foam, dry chemicals, sand, earth.

Small Fires: Large Fires:

Use alcohol type foam or water spray. Keep containers cool by spraying with

Accident Release Measures:

Extinguish any naked flames or sources of ignition. Avoid inhaling vapour. Evacuate personnel from area. Contain or absorb liquid using sand or earth. Do not allow to enter drains, if it has, inform Fire Service.

Transfer into suitable containers for recovery or disposal.

Handling and Storage:

Avoid contact with skin and eyes. Avoid inhaling vapour. Use in well ventilated area. Keep in tightly closed, clearly labelled containers. No Smoking. Naked flames, hot elements, or other ignition sources must not be present. Storage and handling should be adequately earthed to prevent build up of static discharges.

Suitable:

Containers mild steel and stainless steel.

Unsuitable:

aluminium, copper.

8. Exposure controls/personal protection:

Avoid inhaling vapour. Avoid contact with Skin and eyes. Water PVC gloves and safety glasses. Ensure good ventilation. Use a self contained breathing set if high vapour concentrations are present.

10. Stability and reactivity:

Stable. Will react with strong oxidising agents. Burning can produce the following combustion products; carbon dioxide in sufficient concentrations can act as an asphyxiant and or carbon monoxide which is highly toxic if inhaled.

11. Toxicological Information:

Inhalation of high concentrations of vapour may cause headache, irritation of nose, throat, and respiration tract. Ingestion may cause vomiting, loss of coordination temporary or permanent blindness, coma, or death. It is unlikely to be irritating to the skin.

12. Ecological Information:

Mobility:

Ethanol will dissolve rapidly in water and is poorly absorbed onto soils or sediments.

Biodegradability: Bio accumulation: Ethanol is expected to be readily biodegradable.

Ethanol is unlikely to bioaccumulate.

Ecotoxicity:

Ethanol is rated as non-hazardous to aquatic species. Tests on the following species gave a 24 h LC50 of 11400mg/litre: trout. Toxicity threshold concentration

(cell multiplication inhibition test) 5000mg/litre algae.
